Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They started out as a small machine shop at first employing four people. Sales for their initial year of operation totaled 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. During five years of operation, the business had stretched to forty staff and their annual sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Now, Cascade is one of the leading international makers in the material handling industry.

Manufacture and design of the company's first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of better business possibilities. Over the last sixty years, the material handling trade has developed into a highly complex field and Cascade has proudly played a part in this growth. Cascade currently continues to develop as the premier provider of forklift attachments and numerous associated products. The business feels assured in their capability in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive in the global market.

In the 1950's, Cascade started designing, making and promoting hydraulic attachments. Construction was done in 1956 on a new facility in order to accommodate all the plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current headquarters. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total workers reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached nearly \$2,300,000.

1959 in Springfield, Downey a second production facility was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry while the company established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In the year 1964, the business altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental USA to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already existing plants in Springfield, Downey and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are manufactured internationally because of numerous subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is designed to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of 5 corporations, together with the international best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
