Seat for Forklifts - A seat is a strong, strong surface to sit down, typically raised above floor level. Normally utilized by a single individual, nearly all seats are on the support of four legs, even though a few can be in a triangular shape using only three legs. A stool is a kind of seat which does not have a back or any arm rests. A seat which has folding action and an inclining footrest is known as a recliner, while a seat together with arms only is considered an arm seat. If a seat has attached wheels, it can be called a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is known as a swing. A permanently connected seat in a theatre or a train is called a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the type utilized within automobiles and an infant car seat will be a seat particularly intended for little children.

A seat design can differ so as to accommodate many different requirements and aesthetic tastes. For instance, the design can be decorated with drilled holes, be made of porous materials or comprise a low back or gaps for ventilation. The seat back could be designed as an included headrest by way of extending the height over the occupant's head. Seats could be made with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool which is intended to be utilized as a movable footrest. Every so often the ottoman can be mounted to a glider chair with swing arms, allowing the ottoman to rock back and forth together with the glider like a rocking chair along with a built-in footrest.

Seat covers are temporary textile covers meant for a seat which could provide protection against wear and add beauty. A huge range of seat covers from neoprene to leather are presently obtainable. More formal materials can be rented for occasions such as weddings so as to increase the decoration. Some seat covers have decorative seat ties or bows connected to be tied at the rear of the seat in a ribbon or decorative knot. Various people use custom-made clear plastic furniture covers to be able to protect their pricey sofas and seats.

Seat pads provide cushioning for hard seats, though some are normally decorative. Several can also be used to be able to add to a driver's height within vehicles. Also, orthopaedic backrests provide lower spine and lumbar support. Some makers have their seat pad designs patented and are recognized by certain medical associations. Several of the newer car seats available are equipped together with built-in and adjustable lumbar supports to be able to provide additional ease to passengers as well as drivers of the motor vehicle.
